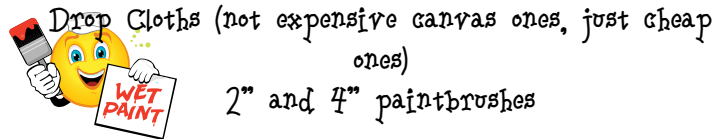

When: Sunday, April 19, from 2:00-6:00 pm

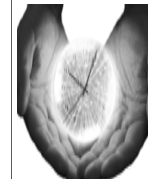
