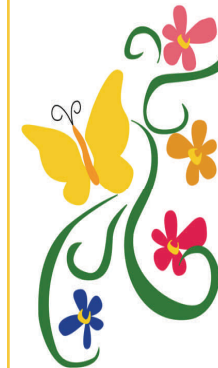
Dear church family,
